Summary of purpose and/or change:

LB 1010 would have reinstated the sales tax collection fee amounts previously paid to retailers prior to 2002. Since 2002, retailers have been paid 2.5 percent of the first \$3,000, or \$70 per month for collection activities. Prior to 2002, the retailer was authorized to receive this amount plus one-half of one percent of all amounts above \$3,000 in one month.
