Summary of purpose and/or changes: Legislative Bill 102 amends N.R.S. 30-2483 to require a personal representative to provide written notice of his/her appointment to the Department of Health and Human Services Finance and Support within 14 days to the appointment. The notice shall identify the decedent’s name and social security number as well as that of decedent’s deceased spouse, if available. The bill applies to personal representatives appointed for the decedents 55 years of age or older or who resided in a medical institution.
