**Summary of purpose and/or change:**

Legislative Bill 1021 would allow an additional option under the enrollment option program if the new option would allow the student to either continue current enrollment in a school district or enroll in a school district in which the student was previously enrolled as a resident student. Students are generally only allowed to option once under the enrollment option program. The current exceptions are for students who relocate to a different resident school district, students in an option school district that merges with another district, and students in an option school district that is a Class I district.
