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Summary of purpose and/or change:

LB 1088 would amend the Nebraska Advantage Microenterprise Tax Credit Act, section 77-5905, to eliminate the \$2 million annual cap on benefits. Currently, applications for benefits are considered first come first served until the \$2 million cap is reached. The bill would be operative retroactively to January 1, 2008 and it carries the emergency clause.

Explanation of amendments, if any:

The Committee amendment would increase, rather than eliminate, the cap. Under the Committee amendment, the cap would increase from \$2 million to \$3 million in 2009 and \$5 million in 2010. The Microenterprise Act sunsets after 2010.
