### Summary of purpose and/or change:

LB 1091 requires the Department of Roads to issue a permit for access to a critical access hospital along an expressway.

DOR has rules and regulations that permits construction for the use of a private entrance or exit connected to a highway right-of-way. DOR has discretion as to the terms and granting of the permit.

The bill requires DOR to issue a permit for the construction of a private entrance or exit on the right-of-way of an expressway if three conditions are met:

- 1. the access is to provide entry to a critical access hospital;
- 2. a majority of the local governing authority approves such access; and
- 3. the access does not cross any lane of the expressway.
