Summary of purpose and/or change:

LB 1145 extends four dates under the Petroleum Release Remedial Action Act from June 30, 2009 to June 30, 2012.

- Section 1 States that money in the Petroleum Release Remedial Action Cash Fund may be used for reimbursement for the costs of a remedial action by a responsible party or by the Department of Environmental Quality in response to a release reported after July 17, 1983 and on or before June 30, 2012.
- Section 2 States that the department is required to provide reimbursement for the costs of remedial action for releases reported after July 17, 1983 and on or before June 30, 2012.
- Section 3 Allows any responsible party who has undertaken remedial action for releases reported after July 17, 1983 and on or before <u>June 30, 2012</u>, to apply to the department for reimbursement for those costs.
- Section 4 Allows the department to undertake remedial actions in response to a release reported after July 17, 1983 and on or before <u>June 30, 2012</u> and to use the money in the fund to pay for those actions.
