Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Legislative Bill 150 would increase fees for teaching certificates and permits.

Section 79-809 would be amended by replacing the language specifying the maximum fees for teaching certificates and permits with a reference to § 79-810.

Section 79-810 would be amended by increasing the fee for a certificate or permit valid in all schools from \$45 to \$55. Provisions for the fee for a certificate or permit valid only in nonpublic schools would be transferred from § 79-809 and would be increased from a maximum of \$30 to a required \$40. The fee for additional endorsements would be increased from \$30 to \$40. Obsolete language would be eliminated.

The measure contains an emergency clause.
