Summary of purpose and/or changes: Legislative Bill 154 amends N.R.S. §25-1601 (Cumm. Supp. 2006) by removing the provision allowing for potential jurors who are sixty-five years of age or older to be exempted from serving on grand and petite juries. The bill also removes redundant language regarding nursing mothers requesting to be excused from jury service.
