First LB 209 would create a new cash fund, the Mechanical Safety Inspection Fund. Secondly, LB 209 would consolidate three existing cash funds: (1) the Elevator Inspection Fund, (2) the Nebraska Amusement Ride Fund, and (3) the Conveyance Inspection Fund; and merges them into the Mechanical Safety Inspection Fund.
