Summary of purpose and/or changes: Legislative Bill 221 amends NRS §§42-353, 43-1101, and 43-1803 to replace the word “date” with the word “year” in the complaint and notice provisions. Under the bill, pleading documents and notice documents must include the year of birth, rather than the full date, of each child whose custody, welfare, or visitation may be affected by the proceedings.
