References are made to the International Registration Plan; Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations as its different parts pertain to apportionable vehicle registration, shipment of etiologic agents, motor carriers transporting persons or property, the shipment of hazardous materials in intrastate commerce, and agricultural operations; the Patriot Act as it pertains to the
