Summary of purpose and/or changes: This legislation proposes to amend section 17-503.02 which deals with the power of second class cities and villages to convey personal property, specifying the procedure for doing so.

The bill would add a new subdivision (2) to the section which provides an exception to the procedure set out in the current statute (new subdivision (1) of the section).

Basically, the current procedure need not be followed in one of two circumstances: if the property is being sold in compliance with the requirements of federal or state grants or programs or if the property is being conveyed to another public agency.
