## **Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 305 adds the term sale or lease to the statutes requiring that motor vehicle sales tax be placed in the Highway Trust Fund rather than in the state General Fund. This directs the sales tax from leasing of motor vehicles to the same funding program as other sales taxes from motor vehicles. Currently these funds flow to the State General Fund.

## **Explanation of amendments, if any:**

The Committee Amendment limits the sales tax collected on leases that would be deposited in the Highway Trust Fund and Highway Allocation Fund to leases that are for a period of more than 31 days.
