LB 349 includes a new section that specifically states the type of trailer and the properly registered motor vehicle that is allowed to tow the trailer. The different types of trailers include a cabin trailer, utility trailer, farm trailer, commercial trailer, fertilizer trailer, pole and cable reel trailer, dealer-plated trailer, and an apportioned fleet vehicle trailer.

Nothing in this section prohibits any motor vehicle or trailer from displaying dealer license plates or In Transit stickers.
