Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 356 would have amended Section 77-1344 to allow agricultural land currently qualified for special valuation or greenbelt status to remain valued as agricultural land even after annexation into a city. Under current law, land inside the limits of a city which remains in agricultural use can be valued as agricultural land only if the land is subject to a conservation and preservation easement.
