## **Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 383 (Pahls), introduced at the request of the Secretary of State, would amend sections 67-236, 67-240, 67-241, 67-281, and 67-283 of the Nebraska Uniform Limited Partnership Act, sections 67-344 of the Uniform Partnership Act, and sections 67-415, 67-454, 67-456, and 67-458 of the Uniform Partnership Act of 1998 to provide that various filings by limited partnerships, partnerships, and limited liability partnerships shall contain the name and street address and may contain the post office box, if any, of the agent for service of process.
