## **Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 390 does the following:

Section 1 (1) Requires the State Fire Marshal to adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to prohibit delivery to, deposit into, or the acceptance of a regulated substance into an underground storage tank at a facility which has been identified by the State Fire Marshal to be ineligible for such delivery, deposit or acceptance;

	(12)	Requires the State Fire Marshal to establish the requirements for training and certification of operators of underground storage tanks.
