Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 484 would require county treasurers collecting tax funds on behalf of fire districts and county agricultural societies to remit the tax proceeds to these local governments in the same manner as they now provide tax proceeds to other types of local government. Currently, fire districts must apply to the county treasurer to acquire such funds through a process which requires two officers of the fire district to sign a warrant requesting tax funds.
