Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Under current law, a written waiver of arraignment and a plea of not guilty offered by a defendant to the district court must include consent and waiver of the right to a physical appearance. Also, a written consent and waiver of a physical personal appearance must be signed by a detainee or prisoner when an audiovisual court appearance is made in nonevidentiary criminal proceedings.

Legislative Bill 533 amends N.R.S. §29-4206 to remove the requirement that consent and waiver of the right to a physical appearance be included in a written waiver of arraignment and a plea of not guilty. LB 533 also repeals §29-4203 outright, thus removing the requirement for written

consent and waiver of the physical personal made in nonevidentiary criminal proceeding	appearance when an audiovisual court appearance is
