Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 544 would have eliminated the provision that prohibits a retail licensee from accepting credit for beer purchases from a manufacturer or wholesaler.

Details

Section 1 amends §53-168, relating to Liquor Control Act violations, by eliminating language that prohibits a retail beer licensee from accepting credit for beer purchases from a manufacturer or wholesaler.

Section 2 repeals the original section.
