Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 546 would have allowed the State Racing Commission to license and regulate pari-mutuel wagering on previous horse races.

How historic racing would work: there is a pool of more than 55,000 past horse races that are shown to bettors on instant racing terminals. The races, tracks, and horses are not revealed, and the order of races are selected and run randomly. Only certain statistics about past performances, track conditions, etc., are provided to the bettor. The bettor places his bet, and then watches a portion of the race before another bet can be placed.

Details

Section 1 amends §2-1203.01, relating to the State Racing Commission's duties, by adding a new subsection directing the Commission to license and regulate pari-mutuel wagering on historic horse races, which is to be limited to \$10 per play and requires the race to be replayed on the terminal long enough so as to "maintain the integrity of such horserace . . ."

Section 2 repeals the original section.
