Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 578 proposes some technical changes to portions of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act. The contents of the original bill have been stricken and replaced by the committee amendment.

Explanation of amendments, if any:

The committee amendment creates new language stating that when the Liquor Control Commission finds that the administration of the state alcohol excise tax laws might be more efficiently conducted, the commission may require or allow “rounding off” amounts on returns or reports to the nearest dollar. The language mirrors a Department of Revenue statute on tax reports and returns. There is no fiscal impact.
