Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 617 amends the Nebraska Behavioral Health Services Act. The bill creates (1) a coordinator of adult behavioral health services and (2) a coordinator of children's behavioral health services within the Division of Behavioral Health Services (division).

The bill requires the division to submit a children's behavioral health implementation plan to the Governor and the Legislature by September 1, 2007. The division is required to

communicate regularly with the Health and Human Services Committee of the Legislature
(committee) and the Behavioral Health Oversight Commission of the Legislature (commission)
during preparation of the plan. The commission is required to review the plan and provide
written recommendations to the division by November 1, 2007. The division is required to
respond to those recommendations in writing to the committee and the commission by December
1, 2007.
