Summary of purpose and/or changes: Legislative Bill 619 amends N.R.S. §84-617 to make charges assessed to payors of bad checks by state agencies available to the state agency to reimburse the agency for the assessments and administrative costs incurred by the agency.

The charges assessed by the State Treasurer go to the Treasury Management Cash Fund to offset the cost of collecting on state agency bad debt.

Explanation of amendments, if any:

AM 360 imposes a thirty dollar cap on the charges assessed by the State Treasurer or a state agency for returned checks or unaccepted electronic payments.
