## **Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 63 (Schimek) would amend section 44-787 of the insurance statutes to provide that group and individual sickness and accident insurance "certificates" issued in this state, as well as policies issued in this state, that provide coverage for a dependent child under six years of age shall provide coverage for childhood immunizations.
