## **Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 640 would have amended the levy limits, section 77-3442, to authorize an additional five cents per \$100 of valuation levy for a learning community for capital projects. The current levy for a learning community is limited to \$1.02 so the total levy allowed under this section would be \$1.07.

Section 2 provided that the additional levy authority in section 1 be used for a one-time buy down of bonded indebtedness for capital projects of members of the learning community. The amount of buy down from this levy was to be no more than 50 percent of the cost of the district's building project. The learning community board was to approve projects for buy down if the project will construct or remodel facilities for (i) focus schools or programs, or (ii) programs to attract a more economically and culturally diverse student body.
