Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 681 amends § 60-1411.01 to increase the licensing fees for motor vehicle dealers, salespeople, manufacturers, distributors, factory representatives, distributor representatives, finance companies, wrecker or salvage dealers, factory branches, auction dealers, as well as motorcycle dealers and trailer dealers. After January 1, 2008, the maximum fees permitted will increase by twice the current maximum amount for each class of license.

The bill also increases the corporate surety bond amount for motor vehicle, motorcycle, trailer dealers from twenty-five thousand dollars to fifty thousand dollars. Explanation of amendments, if any:
