## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 69 earmarks 25% of the grant funds awarded through Agricultural Opportunities and Value-Added Partnerships Act for qualifying specialty crop development purposes. "Specialty crop" is added as a defined term within §2-5415 under section 1. Section 2 amends §2-5416 to add encouragement of enterprises in the production and marketing of specialty crops as an additional enumerated purpose of the Agricultural Opportunities and Value-Added Partnerships Act. Entities eligible for grant awards in §2-5418 is revised under section 4 of the bill by eliminating an eligibility requirement for farming or ranching operations to be part of a collaborative arrangement with other operations or entities.

**Explanation of amendments, if any:** The committee amendment eliminates the earmark of 25% of grant funds for specialty crop projects by striking section 3.
