**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 698 would have required the Department of Revenue to publish and make available tax rate information for taxpayers. The information was to be specific to the taxpayers' property location. Information is required on sales, property tax and motor vehicle tax and registration fees. The Department was to publish annually a set of combined tax rates that apply to property inside each incorporated municipality, and select a set of combined tax rates on properties outside municipalities.
