### Summary of purpose and/or change:

LB 712 provides for an exception from current law for vehicles equipped with daytime running lights designed to operate while the engine is running.

Current statute makes it unlawful to drive with only parking lights turned on. The bill provides an exemption for vehicles designed by the manufacturer to operate with daytime lights.

The bill has an emergency clause.
