Summary of purpose and/or change:

LB 822 adds language to allow the Legislative Auditor to request a performance audit.

The bill also updates the references to the government auditing standards for both the Legislative Performance Audit Section and the Auditor of Public Accounts. Also, the bill changes the references to the "General Accounting Office" to the "Government Accountability Office." This office changed its name in 2004 and these provisions update that change.

Explanation of amendments, if any:
The committee amendment clarifies that the Auditor of Public Accounts is required to develop and maintain an accessible, on-line, financial information system for political subdivisions only.
