Summary of purpose and/or change:

LB 837 repeals the requirement that a railroad crossing with no gates, bells, etc. must be closed if it is within one quarter mile of a crossing with gates, bells, etc.

Currently in statute an objection may be made by an interested party if a written request is submitted by a professional engineer who is familiar with the situation and believes the section shouldn't apply.

Explanation of amendments, if any:

AM 1767 reinstates subsections (2) and (3) in the original bill. A sentence is also inserted at the end of subsection (3) in § 74-1334 that exempts a crossing from being closed if a written request from a professional engineer is received.
