**Summary of purpose and/or change:**

LB 841 authorizes the attachment of a dealer assignment form to a manufacturer's statement of origin (MSO) when all reassignment spaces have been used on the MSO. Current practice requires the dealer to resubmit the full MSO to the manufacturer and request a new MSO to be issued.

The form will be prescribed by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

The reassignment of the MSO allows a dealer to transfer vehicles in stock to another dealer without having to apply for the certificate of title. LB 841 does not authorize a reassignment form to be attached to an issued certificate of title.

The bill also corrects a drafting error in Section 2 by striking confusing language.

LB 841 has an emergency clause.
