### Summary of purpose and/or change:

LB 845 authorizes a civil penalty against a commercial driver who violates an out-of-service order or a motor carrier who knowingly allows a driver to violate the order.

The bill requires the Superintendent of Law Enforcement and Public Safety to issue an order imposing a civil penalty against a commercial motor vehicle driver who violates an out-of-service order. A first violation incurs a fine of \$2500 - \$5000, and any subsequent violation risks a fine of \$5000 - \$7500.

The superintendent shall also impose a civil penalty against any motor carrier who knowingly allows, requires, permits, or authorizes the operation of a commercial motor vehicle in violation of an out-of-service order. The penalty shall be \$2750 - \$25,000.
