Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Legislative Bill 91 would remove school districts with the principal office in a county that is contiguous to a city of the metropolitan class from requirements to be included in a learning community and provisions freezing the boundaries of such districts.

Section 79-2102 would be amended by removing such school districts from the requirements to be included in the learning community established for the city of the metropolitan class which is contiguous to the county where the principal offices of the school districts are located.

Section 79-2107 would be amended by removing such school districts from the provisions freezing the boundaries of such districts until a learning community is formed for the city of the metropolitan class.

The measure contains an emergency clause.
