#### Summary of purpose and/or change:

LB 929 would amend the Nebraska Statutes, by prohibiting a person from hunting, trapping and fishing of any animal in the state of Nebraska.

A person who violates this prohibition would be guilt of a <u>Class I Misdemeanor</u> (1year/\$1,000/ or both) for a first offense and a <u>Class IV Felony</u> (5yr/\$10,000/ both) for subsequent offenses.
