Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 95 would expand the sections of statute referenced in dealing with reimbursement of expenses for persons appointed or retained by the Professional Practices Commission.

The bill would expand the reference of two sections “81-1174 and 81-1177” to a range of four sections that would include 81-1174, 81-1175, 81-1176 & 81-1177 by simply replacing the word “and” with the word “to”.

Section 81-1175 provides that written authorization be given for travel expenses and Section 81-1176 provides for the computation of and appropriate application of mileage rates for reimbursement of such expenses.
