Summary of purpose and/or change:

LB 955 would have removed the changes enacted through AM892 to LB 578 last session.

Section 1 amends §53-169.01, relating to manufacturer's licenses, by reinstating the words, "for distribution and sale within this state" when referring to manufacturers who may not hold wholesale licenses in Nebraska. Strikes the grandfather clause for licensees who had a wholesale license prior to January 1, 2007.
Section 2 strikes the original section.
Section 3 creates an emergency clause.
