Summary of purpose and/or change:

LB 960, introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor, is part of the Governor's mid-biennium budget recommendation. The bill provides funding for (1) implementing the CIR salary ruling on NAPE/AFSCME represented employees, (2) salary adjustments in the classified system rules and regulations addressing pay equity issues related to the CIR ruling, and (3) above projected calendar year 2008 state employee health insurance rates.

Explanation of amendments, if any:

The Committee amendment reassigns health insurance premium costs and salary adjustments to the Energy Office, which is proposed to be a separate agency, rather than a program within the Governor's Policy Research Office. A small increase of \$83 General is included as an adjustment associated with the CIR/compression issue.
