- 9 or a peace officer who is believed by such person to be a child
- 10 under sixteen years of age and in so doing:
- 11 (a) Uses or transmits any indecent, lewd, lascivious, or
- 12 obscene language, writing, or sound;
- 13 (b) Transmits or otherwise disseminates any visual
- 14 depiction of sexually explicit conduct as defined in section
- 15 28-1463.02; or
- 16 (c) Offers or solicits any indecent, lewd, or lascivious
- 17 act.
- 18 (2) Enticement by electronic communication device is a
