- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

LB 157

1 Section 1. No person shall be prosecuted for any crime

- 2 based solely upon the act of leaving a child in the custody of an
- 3 employee on duty at a hospital licensed by the State of Nebraska.
- 4 The hospital shall promptly contact appropriate authorities to take
- 5 custody of the child.
