A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Commission of Industrial Relations;
2 to amend section 48-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of
3 Nebraska; to change the compensation of members of
4 the commission; to repeal the original section; and
5 to declare an emergency.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 48-806, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 48-806 As soon as ~~such compensation~~ the same may be
4 legally paid under the Constitution of Nebraska, the compensation
5 of ~~judges~~ each commissioner of the Commission of Industrial
6 Relations shall be ~~two hundred fifty dollars~~ four hundred
7 seventy-five dollars per day for each day's time actually engaged
8 in the performance of the duties of ~~their~~ his or her office.
9 Each ~~judge~~ commissioner shall also be paid his or her necessary
10 traveling expenses incurred while away from his or her place
11 of residence upon business of the commission in accordance with
12 sections 81-1174 to 81-1177.

13 Sec. 2. Original section 48-806, Reissue Revised Statutes
14 of Nebraska, is repealed.

15 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
16 when passed and approved according to law.
