A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Legislature; to create the State-Tribal
- 2 Relations Committee.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. The State-Tribal Relations Committee is hereby  
2 established as a special legislative committee with the intent of  
3 fostering better relationships between the state and the federally  
4 recognized Indian tribes within the state. The Executive Board  
5 of the Legislative Council shall appoint seven members of the  
6 Legislature to the committee. The appointments shall be based on  
7 interest and knowledge. The chairperson and vice-chairperson of the  
8 State-Tribal Relations Committee shall also be designated by the  
9 executive board. All appointments shall be made within the first  
10 six days of the legislative session in odd-numbered years. Members  
11 shall serve two-year terms corresponding with legislative sessions  
12 and may be reappointed for consecutive terms. The committee shall  
13 meet as necessary to, among other things, consider, study, monitor,  
14 and review legislation that impacts state-tribal relations issues  
15 and to present draft legislation and policy recommendations to the  
16 appropriate standing committee of the Legislature.
