Section 1. Section 81-1346, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

LB 5

3 81-1346 There is hereby established a program to be known as the employee suggestion system to encourage the development of 4 5 ideas for improving the economy and efficiency of state government<sub>au</sub> and to grant awards for ideas of proper merit and implement them 6 in the governmental process. The employee suggestion system shall 7 8 apply to all state personnel except those personnel listed in 9 subdivisions (1) (n), (o), and (s) of section 81-1316, any judge, or 10 any elected official.

Sec. 2. Section 81-1350, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

13 81-1350 Any award granted shall be the greater of 14 twenty-five <u>one hundred</u> dollars or ten percent of the amount 15 of savings referred to in section 81-1353 but not to exceed the 16 limitations provided for in section 81-1351.

Sec. 3. Section 81-1351, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

19 81-1351 Any award granted under the provisions of 20 sections 81-1346 to 81-1354 shall be limited to <u>five six</u> thousand 21 dollars unless a larger award is recommended by resolution of the 22 Legislature.

Sec. 4. Original sections 81-1346, 81-1350, and 81-1351,
Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
