A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to amend section 79-10,138, Reissue
2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions
3 relating to school breakfasts; to provide an operative
4 date; to repeal the original section; and to declare an
5 emergency.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 79-10,138, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 79-10,138 ~~The Legislature~~ State Department of Education
4 shall reimburse each qualified public school in Nebraska a portion
5 of the cost of such school's school breakfast program in the
6 amount of five cents per school breakfast served by such school
7 in the second preceding school year. To qualify, a school district
8 shall operate a school lunch program and shall submit information
9 regarding the number of breakfasts served in a manner prescribed
10 by the department. The Legislature shall appropriate money from
11 the General Fund to carry out this section. ~~If the Legislature~~
12 ~~does not appropriate sufficient funds to fully reimburse each~~
13 ~~qualified public school under this section,~~ each such school shall
14 be reimbursed a pro rata amount based on the proportion that the
15 amount appropriated by the Legislature bears to the total amount
16 needed to fully reimburse each qualified public school under this
17 ~~section.~~

18 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2007.

19 Sec. 3. Original section 79-10,138, Reissue Revised
20 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.

21 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
22 when passed and approved according to law.
