A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to education; to amend section 79-1232, Reissue  
2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for and change  
3 provisions relating to insurance coverage for members of  
4 any school board, board of education, learning community  
5 coordinating council, or educational service unit board;  
6 to repeal the original section; and to outright repeal  
7 section 79-502, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.  
8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. The school board or board of education of any  
2 Class I, II, III, IV, V, or VI school district may permit its  
3 members to participate in the school district's hospitalization,  
4 medical, surgical, accident, sickness, or term life insurance  
5 coverage or any one or more of such coverages. A board member  
6 electing to participate in the insurance program of the school  
7 district shall pay both the employee and the employer portions of  
8 the premium for such coverage.

9           A school board or board of education which opts to permit  
10 its members to participate in insurance coverage under this section  
11 shall report quarterly at a board meeting the board members who  
12 have elected such coverage. Such a report shall be made available  
13 in the school district office for review by the public upon  
14 request.

15           Sec. 2. A learning community coordinating council may  
16 permit members of such council to participate in the learning  
17 community's hospitalization, medical, surgical, accident, sickness,  
18 or term life insurance coverage or any one or more of such  
19 coverages. A learning community coordinating council member  
20 electing to participate in the insurance program of the learning  
21 community shall pay both the employee and the employer portions of  
22 the premium for such coverage.

23           A learning community coordinating council which opts to  
24 permit its members to participate in insurance coverage under this  
25 section shall report quarterly at a council meeting the council

1 members who have elected such coverage. Such a report shall be made  
2 available in the learning community office for review by the public  
3 upon request.

4           Sec. 3. Section 79-1232, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
5 Nebraska, is amended to read:

6           79-1232 The board of any educational service unit may  
7 provide its members with permit its members to participate in  
8 the educational service unit's hospitalization, medical, surgical,  
9 accident, sickness, or term life insurance coverage or any one or  
10 more of such coverages. A board member electing to participate in  
11 the insurance program of the educational service unit shall pay  
12 both the employee and the employer portions of the premium for such  
13 coverage.

14           An educational service unit board which opts to permit  
15 its members to participate in insurance coverage under this section  
16 shall report quarterly at a board meeting the board members who  
17 have elected such coverage. Such a report shall be made available  
18 in the educational service unit office for review by the public  
19 upon request.

20           Sec. 4. Original section 79-1232, Reissue Revised  
21 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
