1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDREDTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA,
2 FIRST SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

3 Section 1. At a special election held in conjunction
4 with the statewide primary election in 2010 the following proposed
5 amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to the
6 electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:

7 To amend Article III, section 7:

8 III-7 At the general election to be held in November
9 1964, one-half the members of the Legislature, or as nearly thereto
10 as may be practicable, shall be elected for a term of four years
11 and the remainder for a term of two years, and thereafter all
12 members shall be elected for a term of four years, with the
13 manner of such election to be determined by the Legislature. When

1 the Legislature is redistricted, the members elected prior to
2 the redistricting shall continue in office, and the law providing
3 for such redistricting shall where necessary specify the newly
4 established district which they shall represent for the balance
5 of their term. Each member shall be nominated and elected in a
6 nonpartisan manner and without any indication on the ballot that
7 he or she is affiliated with or endorsed by any political party
8 or organization. ~~Each~~ Until January 5, 2011, each member of the
9 Legislature shall receive a salary of not to exceed one thousand
10 dollars per month during the term of his or her office. Beginning
11 January 5, 2011, each member of the Legislature shall receive an
12 annual salary during his or her term of office equal to twenty-two
13 thousand dollars. In addition to his or her salary, each member
14 shall receive an amount equal to his or her actual expenses in
15 traveling by the most usual route once to and returning from each
16 regular or special session of the Legislature. Members of the
17 Legislature shall receive no pay nor perquisites other than his or
18 her salary and expenses, and employees of the Legislature shall
19 receive no compensation other than their salary or per diem.

20 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the
21 electors in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska,
22 Article XVI, section 1, with the following ballot language:

23 A constitutional amendment to change the salary of the
24 members of the Legislature to twenty-two thousand dollars
25 per year.
