A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Political Subdivisions Tort Claims Act;  
2 to amend section 13-901, Revised Statutes Supplement,  
3 2007; to provide for listings to facilitate filings and  
4 service of process; to provide a duty for the Secretary  
5 of State; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the  
6 original section.  
7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. The Secretary of State shall maintain a  
2 current list of the name and address of the clerk, secretary,  
3 or other official who has the responsibility for receiving the  
4 filings required by section 13-905 and of those persons authorized  
5 to receive service of process pursuant to section 25-510.02. It  
6 shall be the duty of the governing body to notify the Secretary of  
7 State of any change in the name or address of the clerk, secretary,  
8 or other official who has the responsibility for receiving the  
9 filings required by section 13-905 and of those persons authorized  
10 to receive service of process pursuant to section 25-510.02.

11           Sec. 2. Section 13-901, Revised Statutes Supplement,  
12 2007, is amended to read:

13           13-901 Sections 13-901 to 13-927 and section 1 of this  
14 act shall be known and may be cited as the Political Subdivisions  
15 Tort Claims Act.

16           Sec. 3. Original section 13-901, Revised Statutes  
17 Supplement, 2007, is repealed.
