A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section
2 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2007; to prohibit
3 use of computer programs, software, or devices for
4 purposes of ticket scalping; to provide a penalty; to
5 harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement,
2 2007, is amended to read:

3 28-101 Sections 28-101 to 28-1350 and section 2 of this
4 act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Criminal Code.

5 Sec. 2. (1) A person shall not use a computer program
6 or software or other device in a manner not allowed by, or not
7 consistent with, the policies of the ticket issuer for the purpose
8 of breaching or bypassing computer security to purchase or acquire
9 tickets for a cultural or sporting event to be held in Nebraska.

10 (2) For purposes of this section:

11 (a) Computer program means an instruction or statement or
12 a series of instructions or statements in a form acceptable to a
13 computer which directs the functioning of a computer system in a
14 manner designed to provide appropriate products from the computer;
15 and

16 (b) Computer software means a computer program of
17 procedures or associated documentation concerned with the operation
18 of a computer.

19 (3) Any person violating this section shall be guilty of
20 a Class IV misdemeanor.
