A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to railroads; to amend section 17-225, Reissue
2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to impose a penalty for
3 blocking crossings in unincorporated towns or villages;
4 and to repeal the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 17-225, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 17-225 It shall be unlawful for any railroad company ~~or~~
4 ~~for any of its officers, agents, servants or employees~~ to obstruct
5 with car or cars, engine or engines, or with any other rolling
6 stock, for more than ten minutes at a time, any public highway,
7 street, or alley in any unincorporated town or village in the
8 State of Nebraska. Any corporation, ~~person, or firm or individual~~
9 violating any provision of this section shall, upon conviction
10 thereof, be ~~finned in any sum not less than ten dollars nor more~~
11 ~~than one hundred dollars, guilty of a Class I misdemeanor and shall~~
12 be fined one thousand dollars for each offense.
